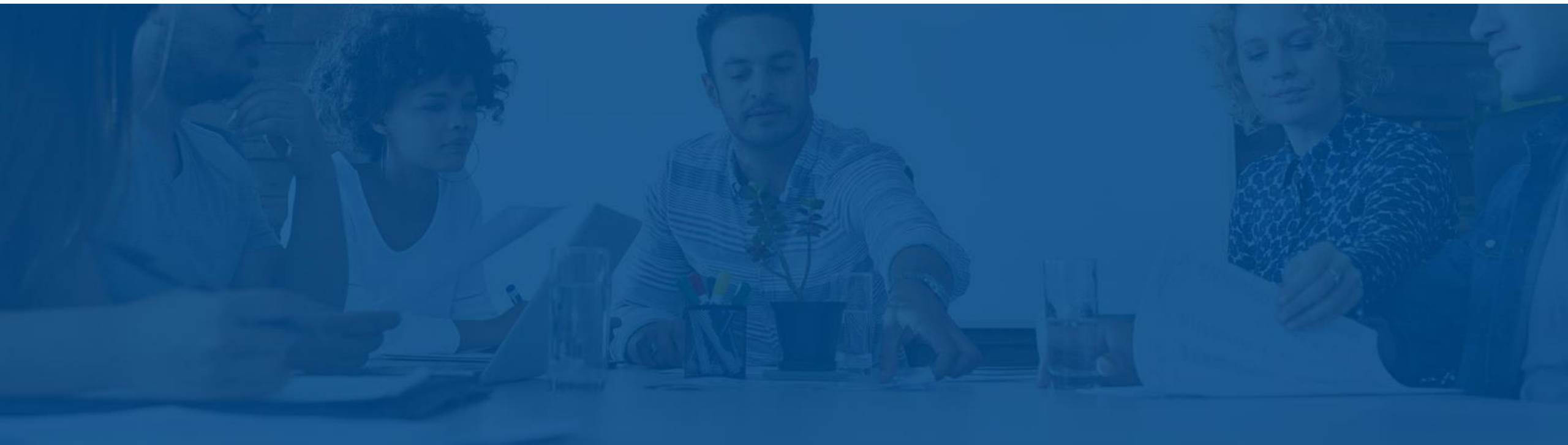

# Problem Statement

## Multiple registrations

„Wir schaffen das.“

(Angela Merkel, August 2015)

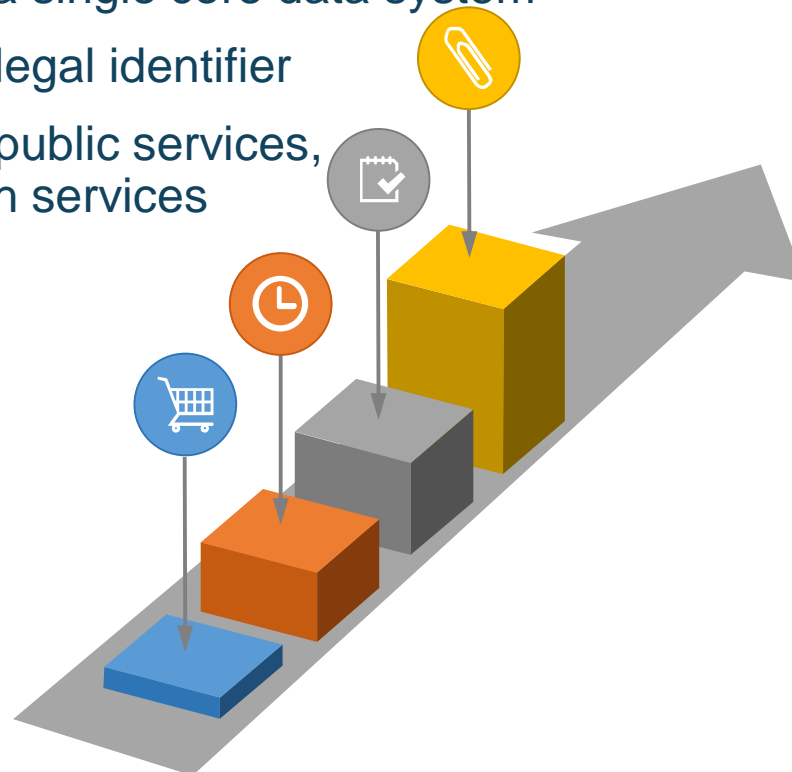
- numerous agencies provide services for refugees and register incoming people, using different IT systems
- spelling mistakes, due to different alphabetical systems or translation errors
- multiple registrations due to misunderstandings or deliberate disguise
- uncertainty about who and how many people are coming into the country
- inefficient allocation or mis-allocation of resources



# How we schaffen das

## Measures taken

- Datenaustauschverbesserungsgesetz (Jan 2016) provides the legal basis for exchange of data among relevant authorities
- data exchange builds on the already established data standard XAusländer
- all relevant authorities access a single core data system
- fingerprint instead of name as legal identifier
- registration prerequisite for all public services, e.g. accomodation, food, health services

2. Immigration Authority (local) in AZR and local IT
3. Reception centre in EASY, Asyl.Online, MARIS, AZR, AFIS-A, EURODAC, ANKUNA, state IT

Federal Authority (BAMF) in MARIS, AZR

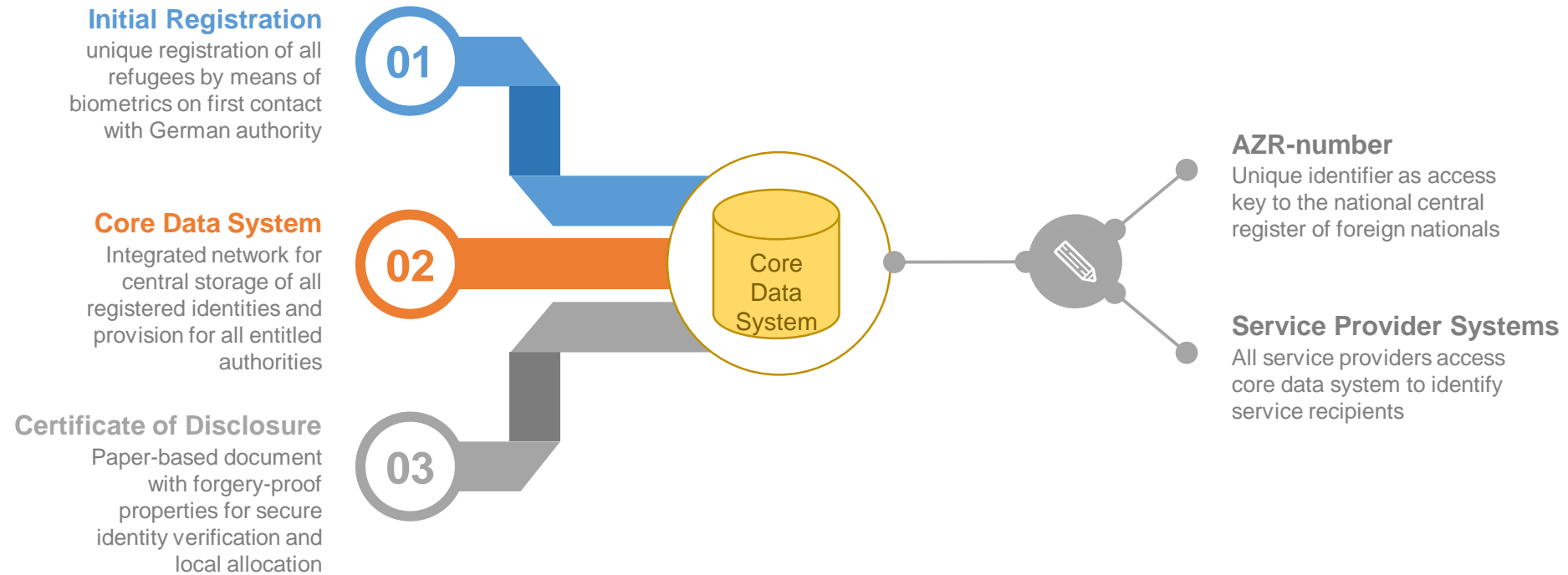

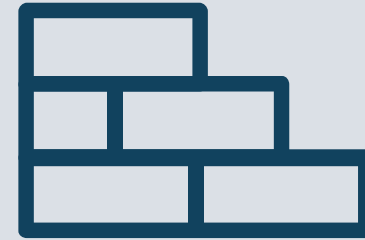
