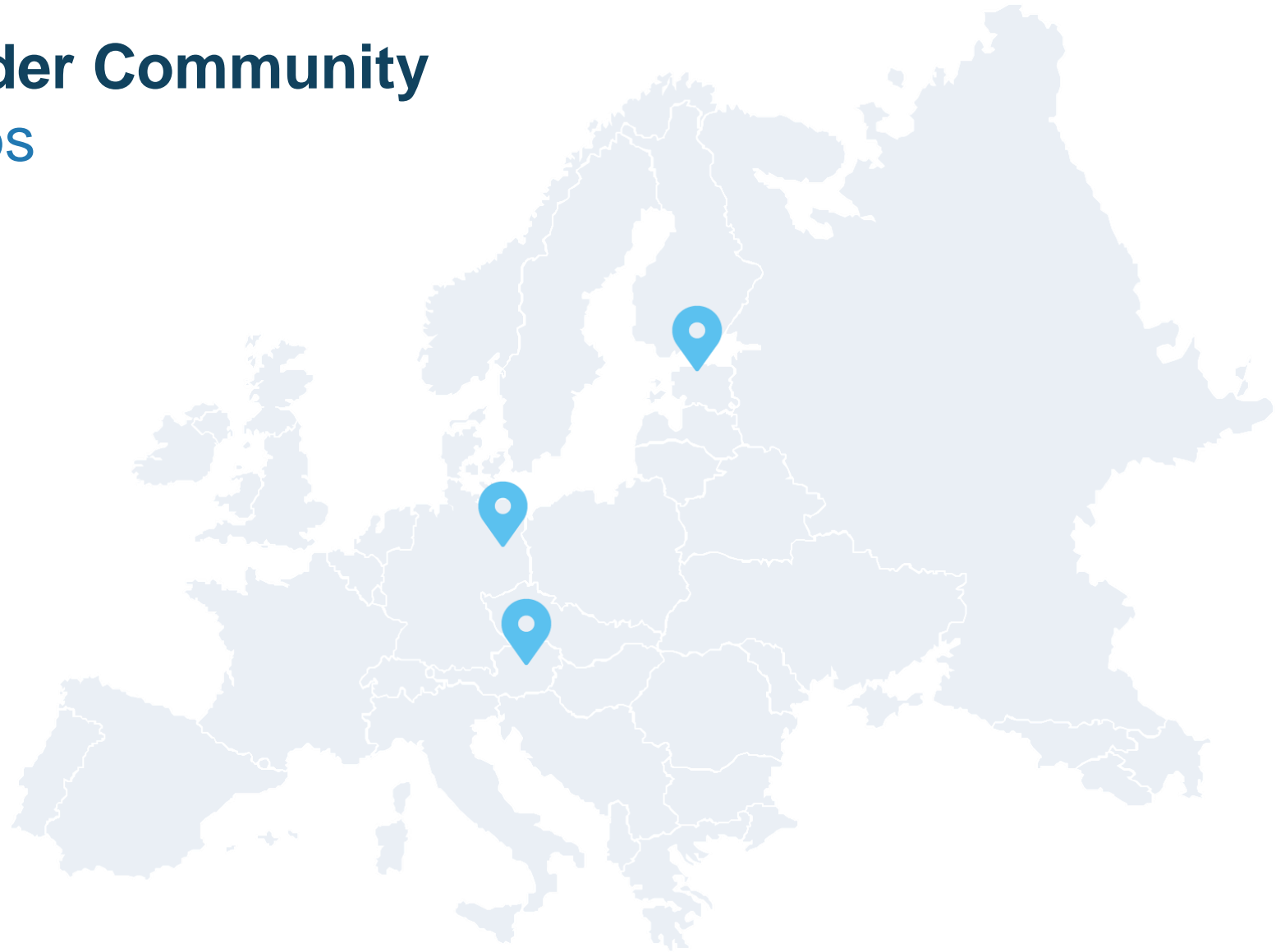
- Holding SCOOP4C presentations and organizing seminars as part of larger, e-government related conferences and events in Europe

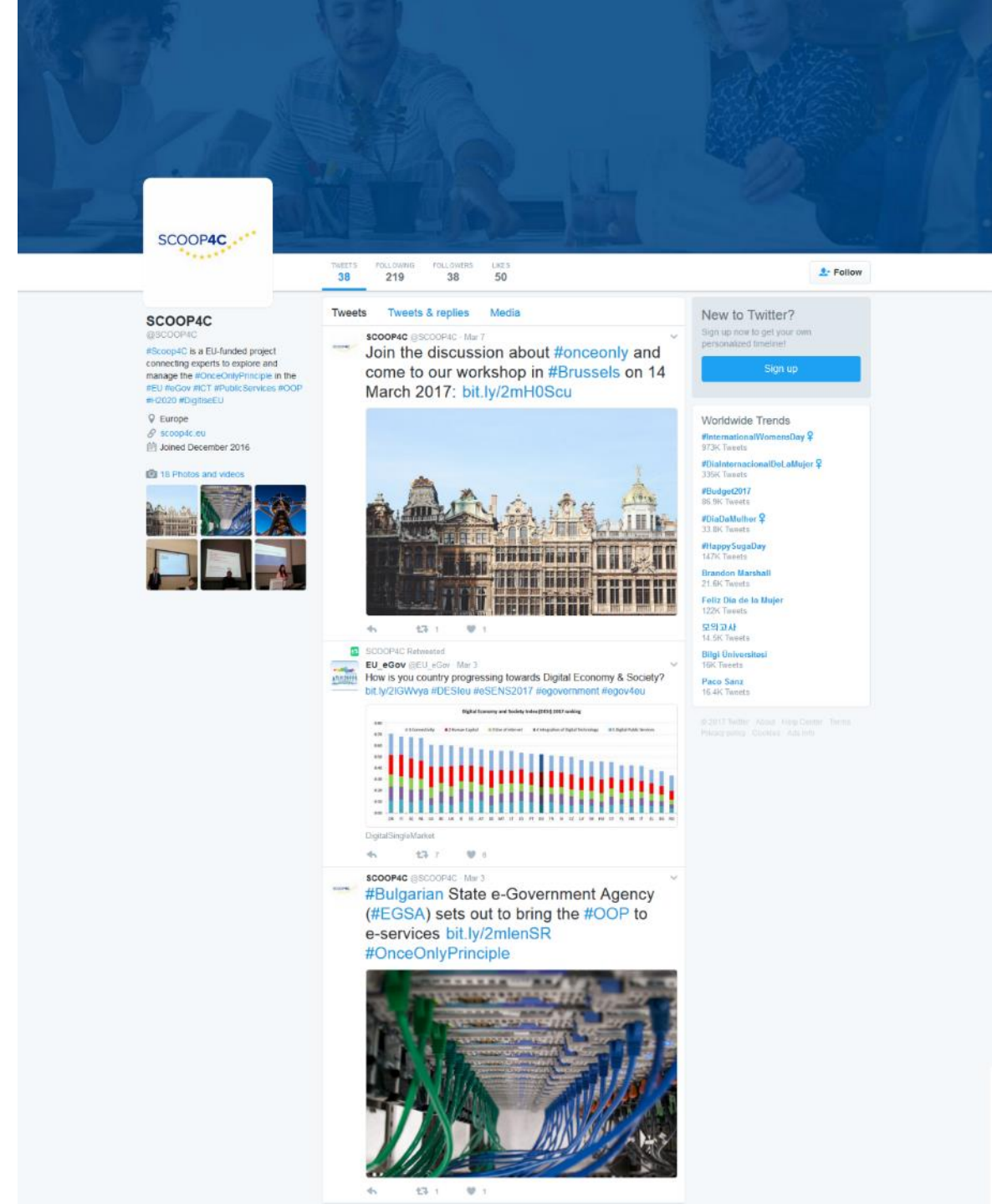

Maria Wimmer from [University of Koblenz-Landau](#) started the session with a presentation of SCOP4C and its objectives to build up a vivid community discussing the ODP for citizens. Furthermore, she presented the vision of ODP for citizens and the key enablers and barriers for its implementation.



Robert Krimmer from Tallinn University of Technology presented the *Once-Only project* TDOP. The project aims to explore and demonstrate the OOP cross border with a focus on businesses. It is a large-scale-project that will build up a cross border architecture of OOP in three pilot areas. The project started on 1st Jan 2017 and will run for 30 months.
