Collecting & storing data only once

Streamlining processes by:

- Enabling automated data sharing
- Replacing redundant data collection with information requests from original source
- Improving data reliability

- Improved service quality and public sector efficiency;
- Compliance with data protection legislation;
- Security, interoperability, data quality, userfriendliness.
- Long-term goal: better functioning DSM.




Online Ship and Crew Certificates

The Cross-Border OOP Case





The pan-European OOP landscape










Piloting update

- Working in an agile way;
- First version of TOOP common components released in May;
- Implementation of TOOP software components;
- TOOP pilots will be ready to test data exchange via TOOP infrastructure in autumn 2018;
- Sweden and Greece the first active implementation:
 - Greek ESPD service deployed with data consumer capability;
 - Swedish Business Register deployed as data provider and data consumer.
- Working on extending the use cases in alignment with SDGR.




Pilot Milestones and Timeline – Current Snapshot
