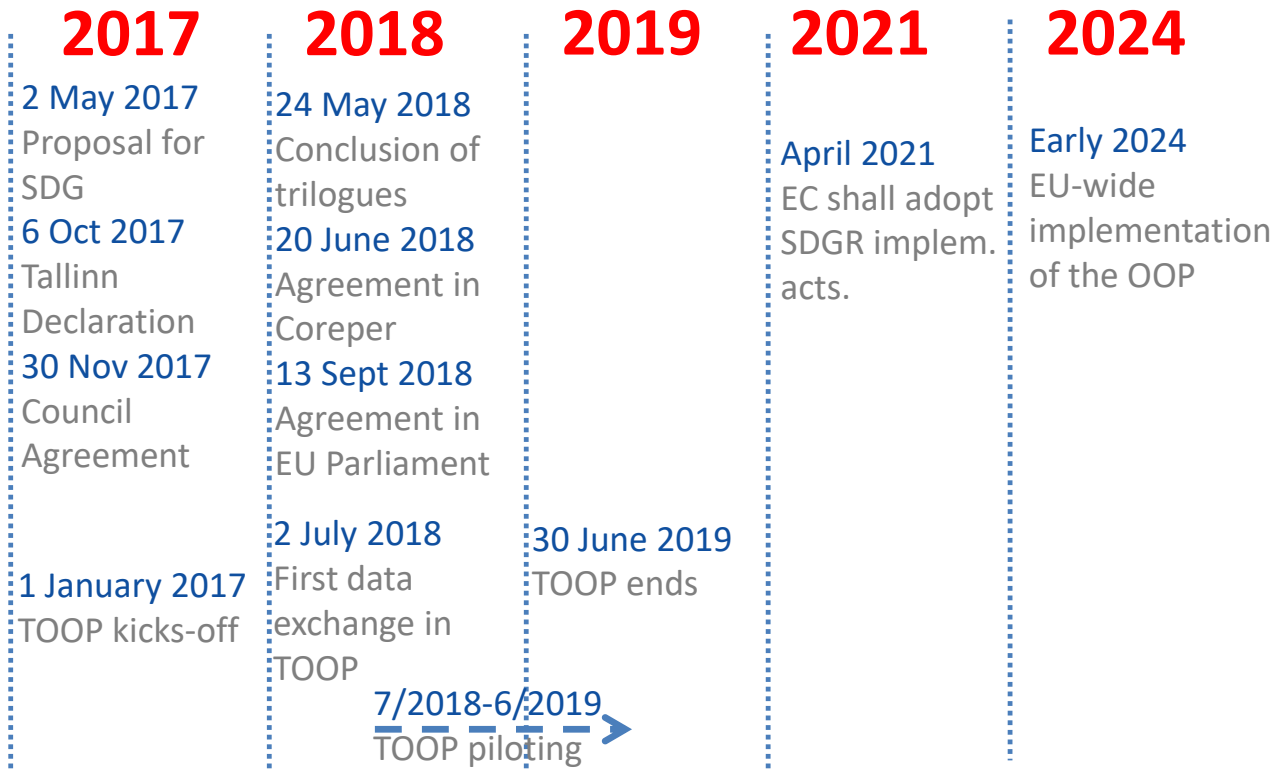

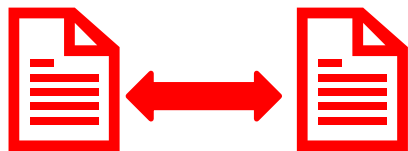
TOOP aims to

Cross-border e-services for business mobility

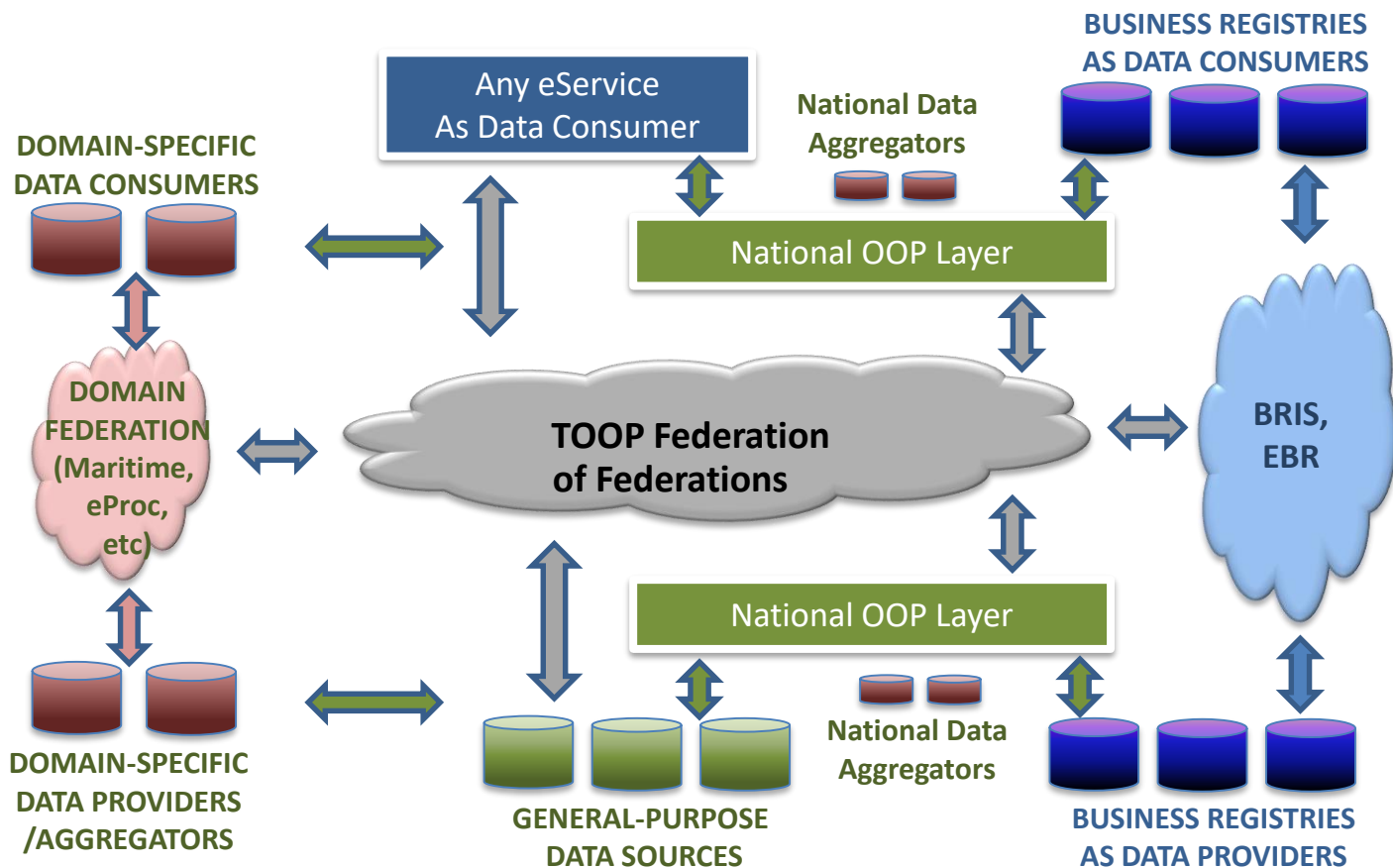


Updating connected company data

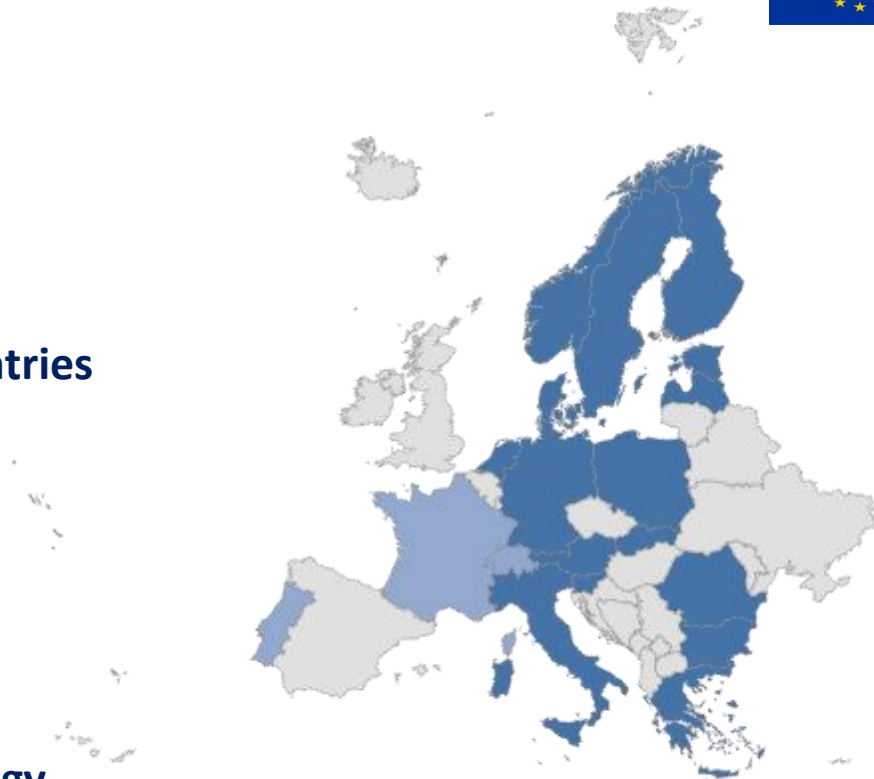
