


#### Domain history and legal basis

- Cross-border interoperability for 10 years
  - PEPPOL LSP (Virtual Company Dossier)
  - E-SENS LSP (system-to-system eTendering)
    - ❖MS implementation now funded by CEF Telecom
- 2014 Directive for public procurement
  - European Single Procurement Document (ESPD)
    - **❖**ESPD Data Model, eCertis
  - Obligation of Contracting Authorities to retrieve automatically evidences available online
- 2018 Single Digital Gateway Regulation (upcoming)
  - eProcurement is included as OOP-enabled
  - Extends OOP obligation to company data




### eProcurement Piloting Landscape








#### Main eProc Flow for Evidence Provision

# A Live demo of data exchange between GR-SE

- A Swedish company participates in a public procurement procedure in Greece.
- He is instructed to complete a European Single Procurement Document (ESPD) online.
- He does not have to enter his company data again because the Greek ESPD service is able to retrieve them directly from Bolavgsverket, the Swedish Business Register, through TOOP.
